AQUATIC PESTICIDE IN USE

Due to aquatic herbicide use in Lake St. Catherine with SePRO ProcellaCOR EC (active ingredient florpyrauxifen-benzyl), authorized under Aquatic Nuisance Control Permit #2770-ANC-C, the following advisory water use recommendations are in effect for the entire lake and outlet stream.

LAKE WATER ADVISORY USE RECOMMENDATIONS

- It is recommended there be NO USE of Lake St. Catherine waters and water from the outlet stream FOR ANY PURPOSE including boating, fishing, swimming, domestic (household) use or irrigation, the day of treatment on:

Tuesday, June 4, 2024, beginning at 9 am

- It is recommended swimming/wading, boating, fishing and domestic (household) use may resume on:

Wednesday, June 5, 2024, beginning at 12 pm

- It is recommended USE of water from Lake St. Catherine FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES including for watering lawns, trees, or other plants may resume on:

Tuesday, June 11, 2024, beginning at 12 pm or earlier based on sampling results, please refer to the website below for up to date results

Bottled water is available upon request by the Lake St. Catherine Association (contact information below) to any person recommended from using their domestic water supply for drinking or food or drink preparation on the day of treatment only.
